In 1981, the artist Vitek Kruta escaped to Germany. He was nineteen years old at the time. Vitek's home was in Prague. He loved his country, but he could not stay there because the government wanted to put him into prison. "The government wanted total control of all art and music," he explains. "We had to have art shows in secret. My kind of painting was against the law. The rock music that my band played was against the law. There was no future for me there."

In Germany, Vitek first had to learn the language. He spent eight months taking lessons at a language school. It was easy for him to understand and read German, but he could not speak it. Then one night, he had a dream. In his dream, he started talking with others in German! The following day, he discovered that he could speak much better.

Next, Vitek got back to his studies in art. He learned to restore (修复) old buildings such as churches and castles. He spent ten years doing this kind of work, and then he faced another big change in his life; He got a job offer in the United States. Vitek knew hardly any English, but he did not let that stop him. After all, he had a great deal of experience learning new languages. So he decided to make the move.

Today, Vitek is a painter, an architect (建筑师), and much more. He is a man with a lot of energy. He works in his studio, he teaches art classes, and he manages an art school. He also likes to bring together people with different talents and abilities to do big art projects in public places so that anyone can see and enjoy them. He says these projects "bring art back to the people".

Professor Walker says students are missing out on an important part of the culture heritage (遗产) because they fail to study classical music, as the little music that children learn at school is mainly pop. The lack (缺乏) of music teaching is serious, especially in government schools where there are not enough specialist (专业的) music teachers.

A national review in 2005 made 15 suggestions, but Professor Walker said it still failed to deal with the lack of classical music taught in schools.

“I’m not against pop music, but it’s very simple, and not difficult either to play or to sing,” Professor Walker says. “But classical music is challenging and although it is part of Australia’s culture heritage, most children learn it only through Hollywood films.”

“At least children ought to know what’s happening in Western culture. It’s part of culture heritage,” he says. “Asian students know more about Western classical music than most children in the West.”

Professor Walker has taught music and music teachers in Britain, Canada and Australia and is a former chief (首席的) examiner for the International Baccalaureate and a former chairman of the research committee of the International Society for Music Education. Professor Walker says no school curriculum (课程) in Australia lists a piece of music that children should study, such as the Mendelssohn’s.

“This lack of standard texts means that some children can be brought up totally on Western classical music, others on Elvis Presley, on any music the teacher wants to teach. The situation should be changed as soon as possible,” he says.
