### 阅读理解

21. B 细节理解题。根据文中对 *When We Go Camping* 这本书的介绍“Get to know nature and all the mystery and wonder she brings as a family goes on an epic outdoor adventure.”可知，如果你喜欢户外探险，你可以购买此书。

22. A 推理判断题。根据文中 *The Watermelon Seed* by Greg Pizzoli 部分内容“Crocodile has wondered (and worried) about it quite a bit! Will he grow a watermelon in his belly?”可知，这个绘本的主人公小鳄鱼把西瓜籽吃进肚子里去了，他很担心肚子里会长出西瓜。

23. D 推理判断题。本部分提到“Dory's ‘Just keep swimming!’ message of perseverance is perfect for any one who has ever felt like they were drowning.”可知这本书的作者希望传达给读者的主要信息就是不要放弃，坚持！

24. C 细节理解题。根据文中第二段“Predicting a journey of only several metres, Bob was wearing just long jeans, a shirt and slippers...”可知，由于木柴离农舍很近，因此 Bob 穿的很少就出门了。

25. B 细节理解题。根据文中第三段“She kept Bob warm by lying on top of him...”可知，金毛躺在 Bob 身上，用自己的身体给主人保暖。

26. A 词义猜测题。根据划线词所在语境“She was letting out this screeching howl...”可知，金毛的叫声是为了引起人们的注意，故可推测 alert 意为“警告，使警觉，使意识到”和 A 项意思相近。

27. D 推理判断题。本文介绍了金毛 Kelsey 在冰天雪地里不离不弃保护主人，最后通过自己的叫声引来了邻居相助，可知 Kelsey 既聪明又忠诚。

28. C 细节理解题。根据“The experiments found that aqua blue napkins enhance the flavor of eggs and Indian food.”可知，C 项正确。

29. D 细节理解题。根据“enhance the flavor of eggs and Indian food”和“increases the perception of sweetness and decreases bitterness”可知，选 D 项。

30. B 推理判断题。通读全文可知，这是一篇科普文章，所以选 B 项。

31. A 主旨大意题。本文主要介绍了各种颜色的餐巾和食物口感之间的关系，所以选 A 项。

32. C 细节理解题。根据第二段第一句可知，未来供热系统通过传感器来控制。

33. A 细节理解题。根据第二段“In the next 30 years, buildings will be made from concrete plastics and shape-changing materials. All of them can heal themselves at that time.”可知，未来楼房可以自行恢复。
