41. B 【解析】考查动词短语辨析。句意：两年后，他们结婚了，在 Ureta 长大的农场里定居下来。A. got prepared 准备好；B. got married 结婚；C. became well-known 变得出名；D. became stressed 变得紧张。结合上文 they fell in love 可知他们相爱两年后结婚了。故选 B。

42. D 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意：Graciela 心中有许多关于农场的宏伟计划。A. tests 测试；B. tasks 任务；C. reasons 理由；D. plans 计划。结合下文 for the farm in her mind 可知 Graciela 心中有许多关于农场的计划。故选 D。

43. B 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意：一天，当 Graciela 乘飞机飞越 Pampa 时，她突然注意到另一个农场看起来像一个挤奶桶。A. train 火车；B. flight 航班；C. cloud 云；D. bridge 桥梁。根据下文 that another farm looked like a milking pail 可推知是在空中看到一个农场看起来像一个挤奶桶，可推测是在乘飞机的时候

候。故选 B。

- 44.A 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：一天，当 Graciela 乘飞机飞越 Pampa 时，她突然注意到另一个农场看起来像一个挤奶桶。A. noticed 注意到；B. remembered 记住；C. recognized 辨认；D. expected 期待。根据下文 that another farm looked like a milking pail 可知她注意到一个农场的形状看起来像一样挤奶桶。故选 A。
- 45.C 【解析】考查形容词词义辨析。句意：Graciela 认为她的家人可以在自己的农场里创造出更有吸引力的东西——一片巨大的森林，形状就像她最喜欢的乐器——吉他。A. expensive 昂贵的；B. funny 有趣的；C. attractive 有吸引力的；D. important 重要的。结合下文 like her favorite musical instrument-the guitar 可知她认为她的家人可以在自己的农场里创造出更有吸引力的东西，形状就像一个吉他。故选 C。
- 46.D 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：Graciela 认为她的家人可以在自己的农场里创造出更有吸引力的东西——一片巨大的森林，形状就像她最喜欢的乐器——吉他。A. treated 对待；B. described 描述；C. considered 考虑；D. shaped 成形。结合下文 like her favorite musical instrument-the guitar 可知是形状像喜欢的乐器吉他。故选 D。
- 47.C 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意：但是 Ureta 并没有把他妻子的想法当回事，他说：“我们以后再谈吧。””A. style 风格；B. personality 个性；C. idea 想法；D. adventure 冒险。结合下文 "We'll talk about it later. "可知 Ureta 并没有把他妻子的想法当回事，故选 C。
- 48.B 【解析】考查副词词义辨析。句意：后来再也没来。A. hardly 几乎不；B. never 从不；C. still 仍然；D. always 总是。根据下文 In 1977, Graciela died suddenly of brain cancer 可知 Ureta 说的“以后再谈”因为 Graciela 的去世再也没有来到。故选 B。
- 49.A 【解析】考查形容词词义辨析。句意：1977 年，25 岁的 Graciela 在怀第五个孩子时突然死于脑癌。A. young 年轻的；B. old 老的；C. common 共同的；D.

special 特别的。根据下文 age of 25 可知 Graciela 死时只有 25 岁，是一个年轻的岁数。故选 A。

50.D 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：妻子死后，Ureta 先生后悔没有满足她的愿望。A. kept 保持；B. suggested 建议；C. enjoyed 享受；D. regretted 后悔。结合后文 not satisfying her wish 可知 Ureta 先生后悔没有满足妻子的愿望。故选 D。

51.C 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：几年后，Ureta 决定，纪念他妻子的最好方式就是创作这件伟大的艺术品。A. copy 复制；B. paint 绘画；C. create 创造；D. change 改变。结合后文 Ureta 为了纪念妻子，于是实现了当初妻子的愿望创造出了“吉他形状”，故选 C。

52.D 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：在当地政府拒绝支助这个项目后，Ureta 和他的孩子们自己承担了这个项目。A. promised 承诺；B. decided 决定；C. volunteered 志愿；D. refused 拒绝。结合后文 Ureta and his children took it on their own. 可知政府拒绝支助这个项目。故选 D。

53.A 【解析】考查动词词义辨析。句意：他们一个接一个地种下了大约 7000 棵树，做成“吉他形状”。A. planted 种植；B. carried 搬运；C. put 放置；D. collected 收集。结合后文 about 7,000 trees 可知是种植了 7000 棵树。故选 A。

54.B 【解析】考查名词短语辨析。句意：这些树花了几个季节才生根，但 Ureta 的努力得到了回报。A. small dream 小梦想；B. hard work 努力工作；C. big success 巨大成功；D. private money 私人资金。结合上文 about 7,000 trees into the "shape of a guitar". It took a few seasons for the trees to take roots, but 可知 Ureta 为此付出了巨大的努力，他的努力最终也得到了回报。故选 B。

55.B 【解析】考查名词词义辨析。句意：看着森林年复一年地生长，Graciela 的孩子们得到了安慰。A. pleasure 快乐；B. comfort 安慰；C. support 支持；D. care 关心。结合后文 "It was the closest thing possible to having my mother alive," Maria Julia, Ureta's second daughter, said. 可知森林使得 Graciela 孩子们也得到了安慰。故选 B。

M: Hello, everyone. First let me introduce myself. My name is John Barker, and I work at an institution. As most of you know, I'm here to talk about students' summer jobs. In many parts of the world, university students work in the summer. They need the money, and they can get some working experience. Traditionally, they get jobs as servers, cashiers, and lifeguards at swimming pools.

These days, however, more and more students are working at dotcoms. Dotcoms are Internet-based companies which offer goods and services online. Today's young people already know a lot about computers, and they can quickly learn more. The pay is usually much better than at the traditional summer jobs.

There are other advantages besides the pay. Students see dotcom jobs as a good start on their future. In addition to providing good experience, the work is also enjoyable for most. On top of this, their co-workers treat them with respect.

Dotcoms are new and need new ways of thinking. Imagination is more important than formal qualifications. So some students are even quitting school to start their own dotcoms.
