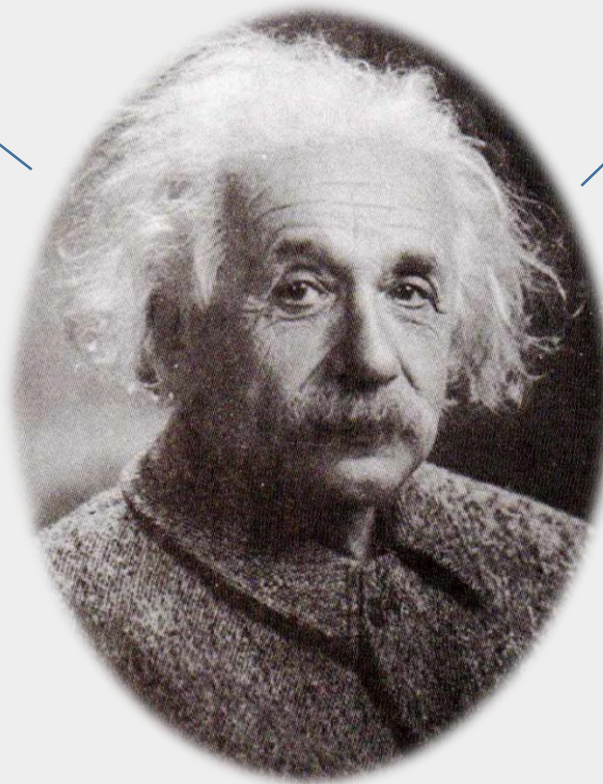

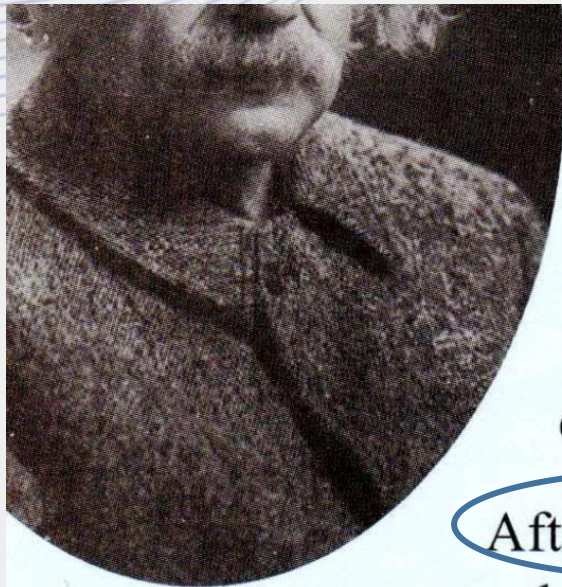

This **gentle** genius was born in Germany on 14 March 1879. When he was 16, he tried to enter university in Switzerland, but failed due to his **1879+16=1895** general part of the entrance exam, despite obtaining exceptional scores in maths and physics. After studying for another year, he managed to pass the exam, entering university in 1896 and graduating in 1900.

After two years of **1900+2=1902** as a teacher, Einstein took a job as a clerk in the Swiss **patent** office. While working there, out of a strong **passion** for knowledge, he continued to study, earning a doctorate in physics in 1905. That same year, which was later recorded as a miracle year in science, he published four **extraordinary** physics papers. Following this, he **gradually** became famous throughout the world as the new Isaac Newton. After four years, he was able to quit his job at the patent office and enter research full-time. In 1922, he was awarded the 1921 Nobel Prize for Physics for **1905+4=1909** photoelectric effect.

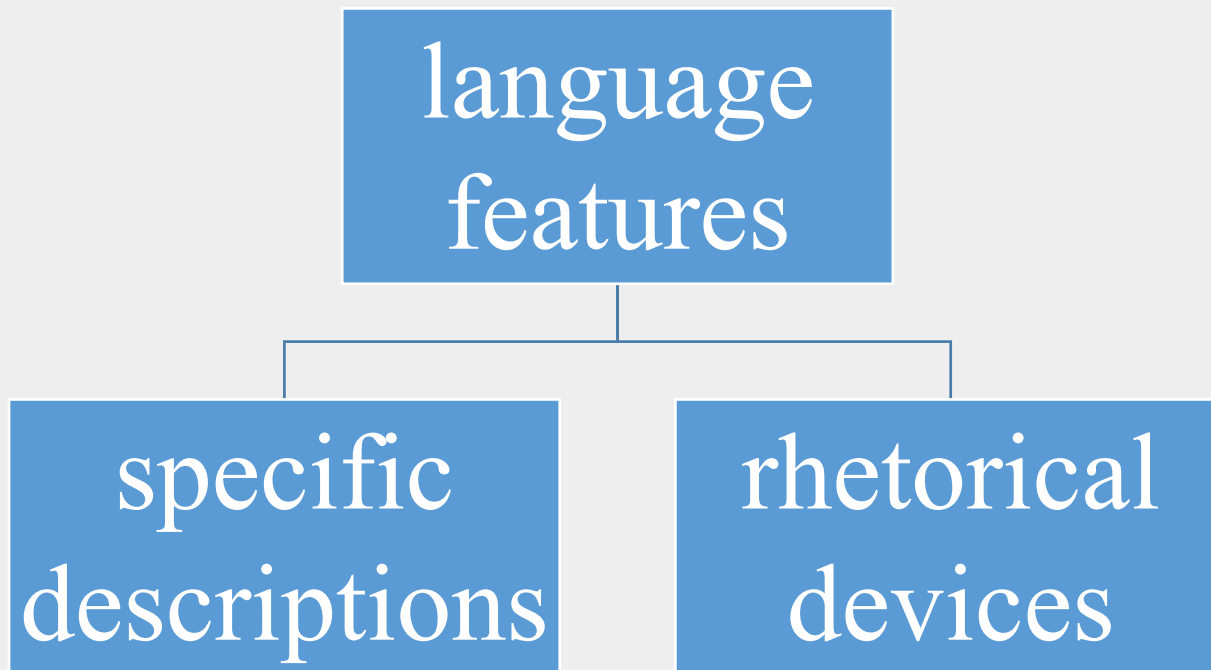

Analogy: a comparison of one thing with another thing that has similar features

The boy will be another Albert Einstein.

Simile: A simile compares two things by using words such as “like”, “as” or “as though”.

It made my spirits fly like a kite in the wind.

Metaphor: It compares two things that are unrelated, but which are similar in some way.

The world is a stage.

Personification: It is when a thing, idea, or animal is given human attributes.

The sky weeps.

Euphemism: an indirect word or phrase that people often use to refer to something embarrassing or unpleasant, sometimes to make it seem more acceptable.

“Pass away” is the euphemism for “die”.

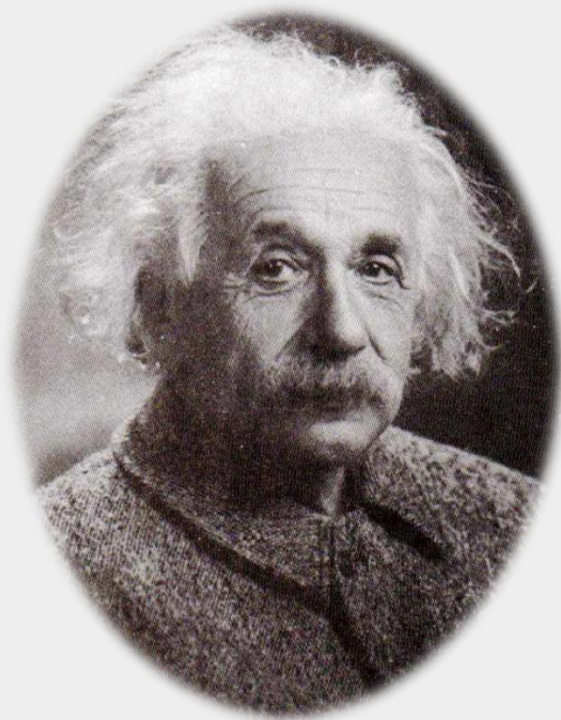

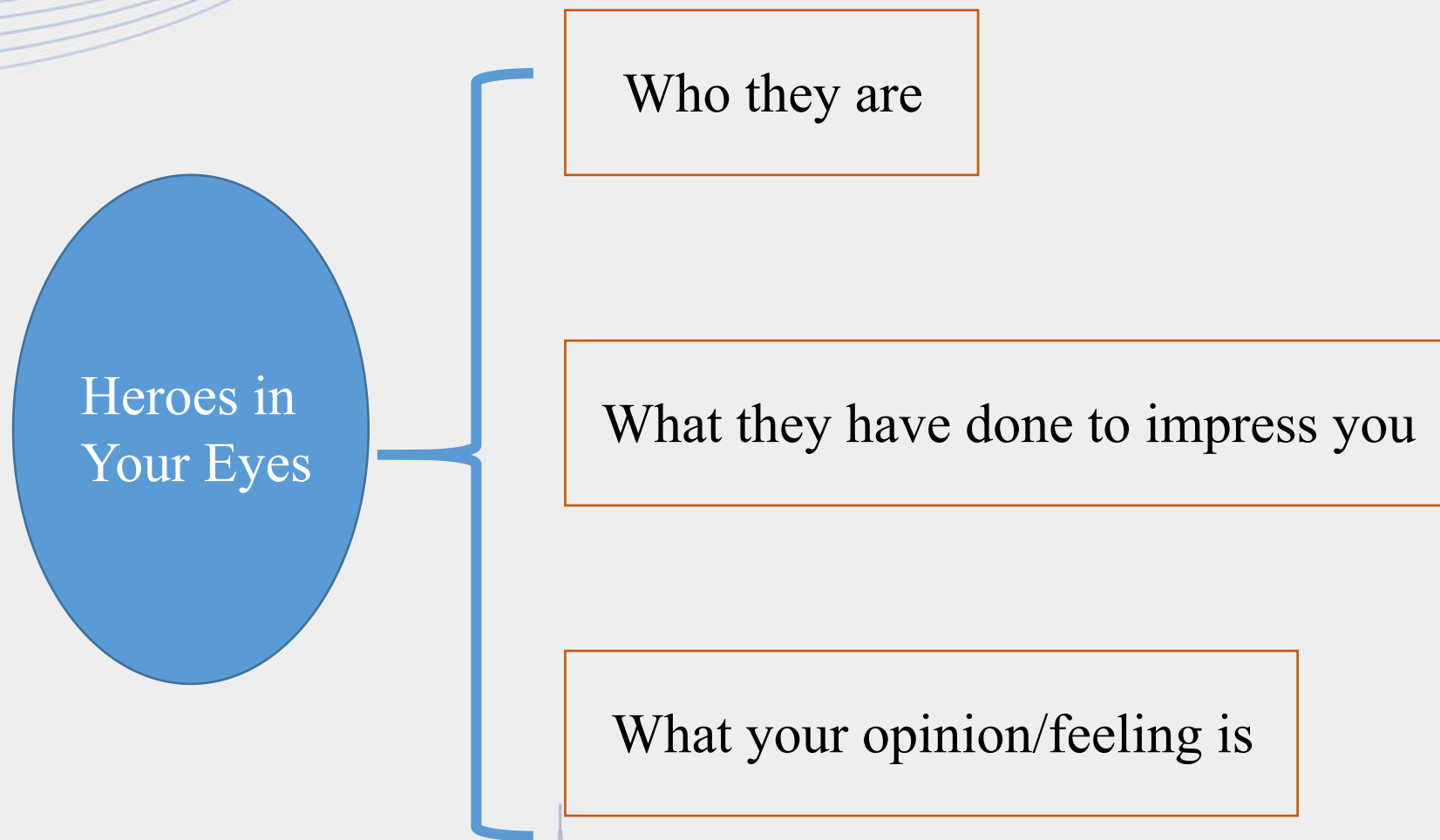
